





Do they meet the needs of academic and professional service staff?


Do they meet the business needs of the University?

- Design purposeful activities that promote learners communicating and collaborating with each other – both for formal and informal learning
- Establish expectations for engagement and interaction to establish value

- Provide ways that they can connect with campus without being on-campus so they can blend the social learning experience with the formal learning experience
- Enable disparate learning communities to connect in both physical and virtual spaces.
